Prayer 24-7 is an international movement.

Participating groups pray 24 hours a day for a week in a dedicated prayer room or large tent. Here in the Tas Valley, we've joined in Prayer 24-7 for a number of years and have found this way of praying to be great – people often find that an hour passes like 10 minutes and many prayers have been answered by God in amazing ways. the photos are from previous weeks of prayer





Anyone can sign up for hour long slots in the room – a chance to pray alone or with chosen friends. It doesn't matter if you're not a regular churchgoer or what age you are. The room is equipped with lots ofaids to prayer in different styles – so you can light candles, listen to meditative music, paint on the prayer art board, enter your prayer requests in a book etc. Being in a room dedicated to prayer like this is often a very moving experience.



This year the theme will be "Come Holy Spirit" – The cells and other groups are designing interactive and/creative ways of praying for blessing on others and meditating on God's word.
