The Archbishops of Canterbury and York have called everyone to a week of prayer for evangelism from 8th-15th May. In the Tas Valley, we are encouraging everyone to use a resource called "trypraying" for that week. Try praying has produced a booklet as a resource for people who are not regular prayers or churchgoers to try praying for a week. It is also available as an app. Christians are invited to use the booklet for themselves during the week of prayer 8th-15th May and also pray about who might like to have the book passed on to them at the end of the week so they can try praying too. We'll be telling you more in sermons and cell notes this month. You can get hold of a copy of the book by putting your name on a list at the back of church (they are £1 each) OR single copies can be ordered for free at www.trypraying.co.uk/try-it/booklet/
