

## Book of Common Prayer (1662) in the Tas Valley Churches

Looking for a BCP service? This is where you can regularly find one:-

**1st Sunday - 8am** Holy Communion at Newton Flotman (From August onwards),  
**9.30am** Matins at Tasburgh

**2nd Sunday - 11am** Matins at Tharston & also at Saxlingham

**3rd Sunday - 8am** Holy Communion at Tharston, **11am** Often Matins at Shotesham

**4th Sunday - 8am** Holy Communion at Saxlingham

In July and August there are also two choral **evensong** services:  
19th July 6pm in the ruins of old St Mary's in Saxlingham  
16th August, 6.30pm at St Mary's Tasburgh (patronal festival)
