

Each House of Prayer member...

- Prayerfully selects 5 people or families from the area which is the focus for the house of prayer who do not yet have a committed faith.
- Plans to pray for them for 5 minutes a day, 5 days a week for 5 weeks. Then review your experience with other members of the house of prayer.

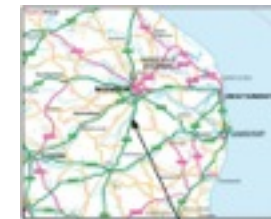

Purpose of a Local House of Prayer

A local house of prayer is an effective prayer-based missional community. It could be a cell with a special focus on prayer. Or a cell could host a House of Prayer Meeting once a month for a wider group. The HoP's purpose will be for God's Kingdom to come in the area for which it prays. God's Kingdom simply means what happens when God is in charge - blessings such as good relationships, joy, peace, economic stability, health, growth, refreshment, love....

TO START:

1. Look for people with an open heart to start this community
2. Each commit to learn to become a house of prayer
3. Each commit that by the help of the Holy Spirit you will seek to live a clean life.
4. Choose a reputable place to meet and pray over and bless it together



WHAT HAPPENS IN A HOUSE OF PRAYER MEETING



1. Start with a time of worship and praise (Recognise God's presence with you)
2. Use the Lord's prayer as a pattern as you intercede for your area
3. Speak blessing over the local area for which you are praying (Use the ideas in the BLESS acrostic (overleaf))
4. Pray collectively over the 5 names each person involved in the House of Prayer has selected, blessing them. (Share testimonies but do not break confidences)
5. Pray to the "Lord of the Harvest" to send workers into his harvest field which is your area.
6. Engage with these questions:
 - a) Who or what can you affirm/bless?
 - b) To whom can you show mercy/kindness?
 - c) With whom can you share the gospel?
 - d) What opportunities is God opening up for you as a group to bless your area?
 - e) Who else should you ask to join this local house of prayer?
7. Keep going. Persistence is key (Luke 18.1) Continue to seek God's Kingdom (Matthew 6.3). Rejoice (Philippians 4.4)
